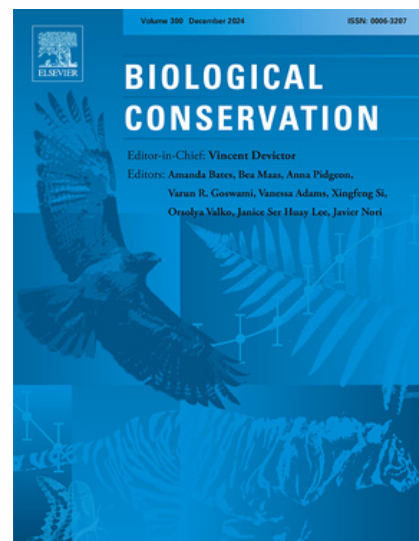
## Projects

### Butterfly Diversity in Tanzania

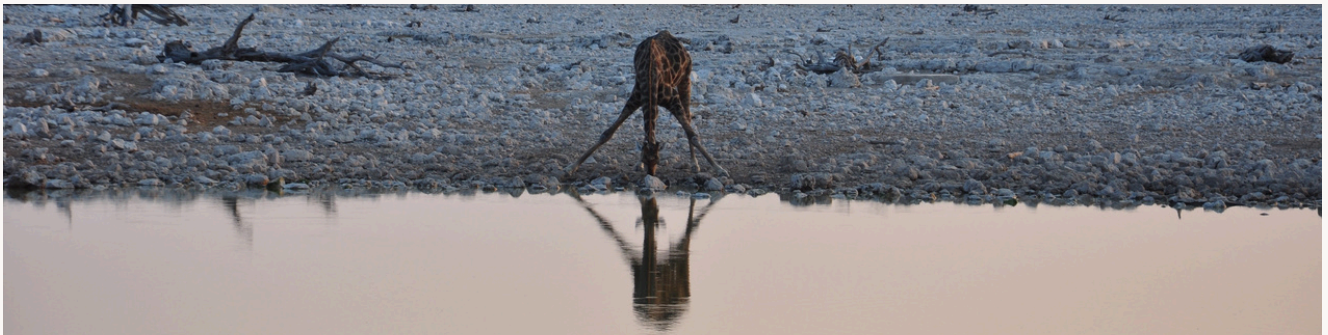
This research focuses on butterfly species richness and composition across different forest types. You would work with data collected during fieldwork in the miombo woodlands of Western Tanzania (2023/2024).
